



Convention Update regarding COVID-19 Concerns

Greetings AIWD Members and Vendors,

We trust everyone is staying safe out there and following your community's guidelines for easing back into "business as usual."

The AIWD Team and our Trump Hotel Representatives are in regular contact, discussing what measures will be taken to ensure a safe, quality event in August. We do have the current guidelines, but also know (and have discussed) that these guidelines can change and/or even ease up prior to our arrival. That said, we want to let everyone know that **every precaution will be taken to secure the health and well-being of our attendees** and we will be following the guidelines set forth by Dade County at that time. This is an ongoing process, so any specific details are subject to modification prior to our arrival.

Although the hotel is currently closed, the golf course is open and tournaments are currently taking place. The only thing that is different with the tournaments is that only one golfer is allowed per golf cart.

As of this notice, an example of some of their current changes are that meals offered will be either "To Go" or Plated

- Servers will distribute the "To Go" meals
- Flatware to be provided as a roll up only
- Tables will not be pre-set with glassware or silverware (these items will be provided once guests have been seated)
- All condiments to be single use
- Coffee Breaks and Beverage Stations will be manned by a server / attendant
- Meal seating where provided, will be set in accordance with minimum distance guidelines

Again, these guidelines above are what has been set forth by Dade County for all hotels. Although basic safety guidelines will be suggested for our off-site excursions, it does not appear that they will have much impact on the experience. All of us are being updated constantly with new information, sometimes to the point it is difficult to keep track of what the current rules are. We do not wish to add to this confusion, so we will wait to release all the specific guidelines for our event until closer to our arrival date.

We continue to be in contact with our Trump Hotel Representatives and will update the health and safety guidelines as new information becomes available from the CDC and Dade County. We are hopeful that things will continue to improve as they have been, and that we will all see each other in August for a great show. Stay tuned for those updates, continue to stay safe, and thanks to all for hanging in there with us!
